- ◆ Every year, in January, Baroda IT Association (BITA) organizes a 3-day technology fair where all tech enthusiasts from Vadodara showcase their products to the attendees. As a part of the fair, they even conduct a three-stage IT Quiz Competition where students take part to test their knowledge and skills. This year a team of three students from SVIT, Vasad, Tanmay Vakare (LY Information Technology), Kshitij Verma (TY Computer) and Vedant Jain (TY Computer), not only participated but also bagged first position in the competition, displaying their substantial knowledge in the field.

- ◆ Government of India organized Startup India yatra to promote young entrepreneurs and a special achievement was made by the students of computer department. At first stage 'yatra' was organised at zonal level at 4 different zone covering all the cities across Gujarat, from each zone top-10 teams were selected for finale at IIM Ahmedabad. A total of 54 students from third year as well as 3 faculty members (Pro. Shefali Shah, Dr. Roopali Goyal and Mrs. Parul Patel) were benefited by this visit. The students have gained the knowledge about collection and treatment of water for Vadodara city.



- ◆ Department of Civil Engineering had organized a two days National seminar on "Current Issues, challenges and advancements in Environmental engineering" during 2nd -3rd February, 2018 in collaboration with Gujarat Technological University (GTU) for professionals of Environmental engineering / Civil engineering. Expert speakers were invited from Academics, Industries and consultancy services of the field of Environmental engineering. 25 participants from various colleges of GTU had taken the benefit of this National seminar.





# Information & Technology Department

◆ As an integral as well as an auxiliary part of the Information & Technology department, orientation programs were conducted for the students entering the even semester, in various time slots from 10:30 to 12:30, on 26th December 2017. The program was well prepared and scheduled by the professors of the dept., and was attended by a good strength of students. Prof. Nisha Shah, (I/C) HOD, IT briefed the students and discussed the objectives of the new semester for the academic year 2017-18. Useful tips and orientation points were discussed which included:-

- Attendance compulsory more than 75%.
- Exam Schemes.
- Introduction of new subject faculties.
- Skill development and FTKT.
- Teaching scheme discussion (Seminar, ALA, LAB, and LECTURE).
- Virtual Placement.
- The program concluded by the distribution of the TOP 10 certificates to the students by the faculty members.



◆ Seeing the tremendous interest of students in the upcoming genre of IoT, IT department organized a two days workshop on September 15-16, 2017 wherein Prof. Jignesh Patoliya, Assistant Professor, EC department from CSPIT, Changa, introduced the technical know-hows of IoT by conducting a practical session along with a discussion on sensor devices and programming tool 'Arduino'. Around 42 T.Y and L.Y students attended the workshop and were provided with necessary toolkits to perform the tricks and techniques.

◆ A talk on “Developing web application using .NET framework” was arranged on 29th January, 2018 by IT department which was delivered by Mr. Krunal Trivedi, an expert in technologies of Microsoft. It was an interactive session and covered good topics on .NET framework and development of web application using .NET. About 85 students from T.Y. attended this talk.

◆ The Department of Information & Technology, organized a one-day Educational visit to Vikram Sarabhai Space Exhibition, a unit of Space Applications Centre - ISRO, Ahmedabad. The visit was on 30th January, which was attended by 128 students along with 4 faculty members. Scientist H.B. Pandya provided detailed information on SAC activities and their role in ISRO's missions. The exhibition had information panels and working models which further aided in the knowledge gained by the students.



- ◆ The orientation program was arranged on 25th December, 2017 for SY, TY, LY in Computer department. Students were informed regarding their syllabus and subjects. Top 10 certificates were distributed for different category to the students.

- ◆ Computer dept. started 'RED HAT Academy' at the institute. SVIT is a official partner with 'Red Hat Partner' program for one year (February 2018 to February 2019). This certificate course is beneficial for every discipline's students due to it's open source and popularity at industry levels
- ◆ Well, not only in the technical field but also in other co-curriculum activities, the students of Computer department participated enthusiastically. Students like Prachi Nanavati was a part of Basic Civil defense trainee at college level whereas Pushp Rathatava secured 1st rank in Archery at the inter zonal level. Moreover both also volunteered for Vadodara Marathon, 2017 at district level.





# Instrumentation & Control Department

◆ Instrumentation & Control Engineering department had organized an industrial visit at Meghmani FineChem LTD, Dahej on 13th September, 2017. Total 51 students of T.Y., I&C as well as 3 staff members (Prof. Dipesh Shah, Prof. Nilesh Dewani and Prof. Ukti Parmar) were benefited by this visit. The industry persons provide knowledge regarding the process of generation and distribution of electricity based on steam energy. They also provided knowledge regarding different instruments used for plants like recorder, indicators, control valves, actuators, control panels, transmitter, sensors and boiler etc. With the end of the visit, students were benefited by the detail knowledge of measuring instruments, sensors, control valves, actuators etc.



◆ Instrumentation & Control Engineering Department had organized an industrial visit at Wanakbory Thermal Power Station, Wanakbory on 12th September, 2017. Total 63 students of SY I&C as well as 3 staff members (Prof. Janki Chotai, Prof. Divyesh Parikh and Mr. Arpit Patel) were benefited by this visit.
